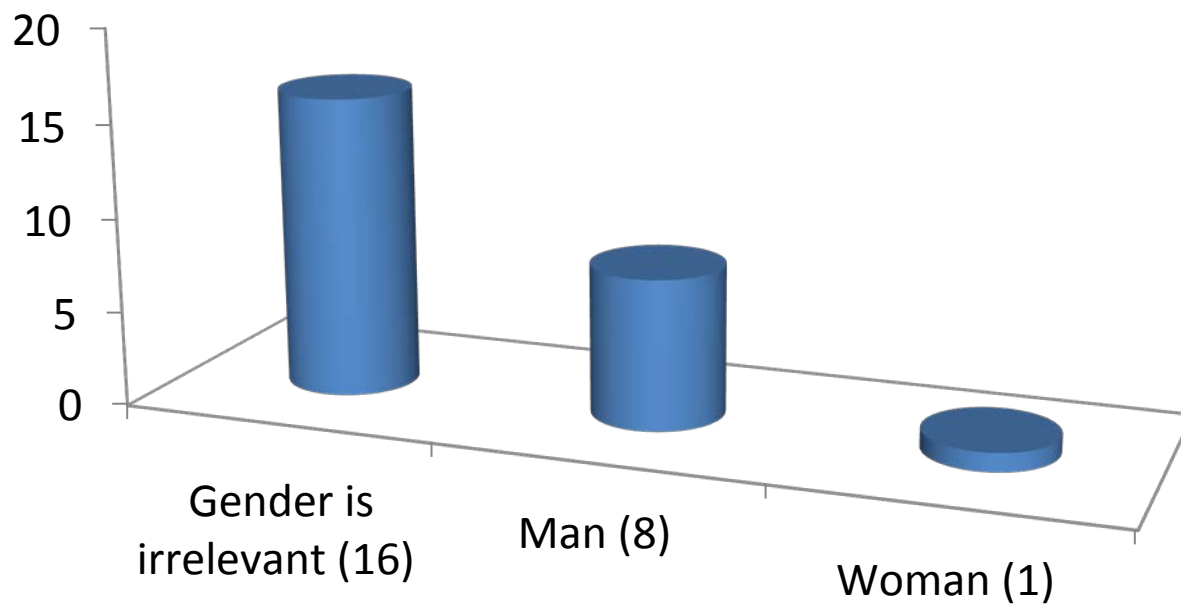

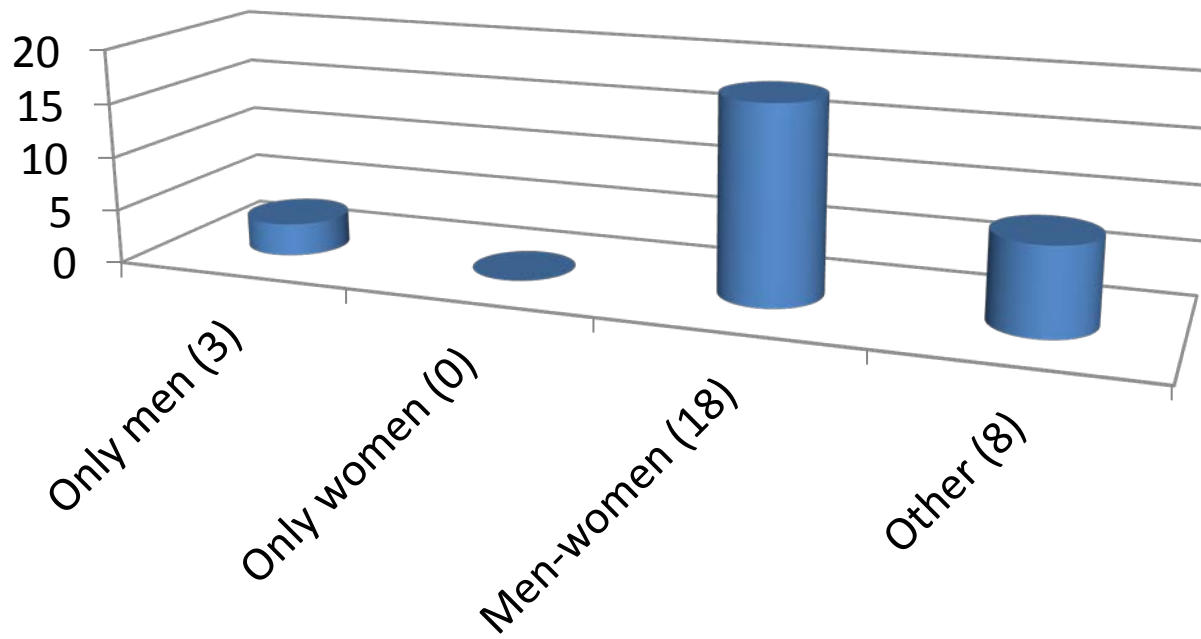

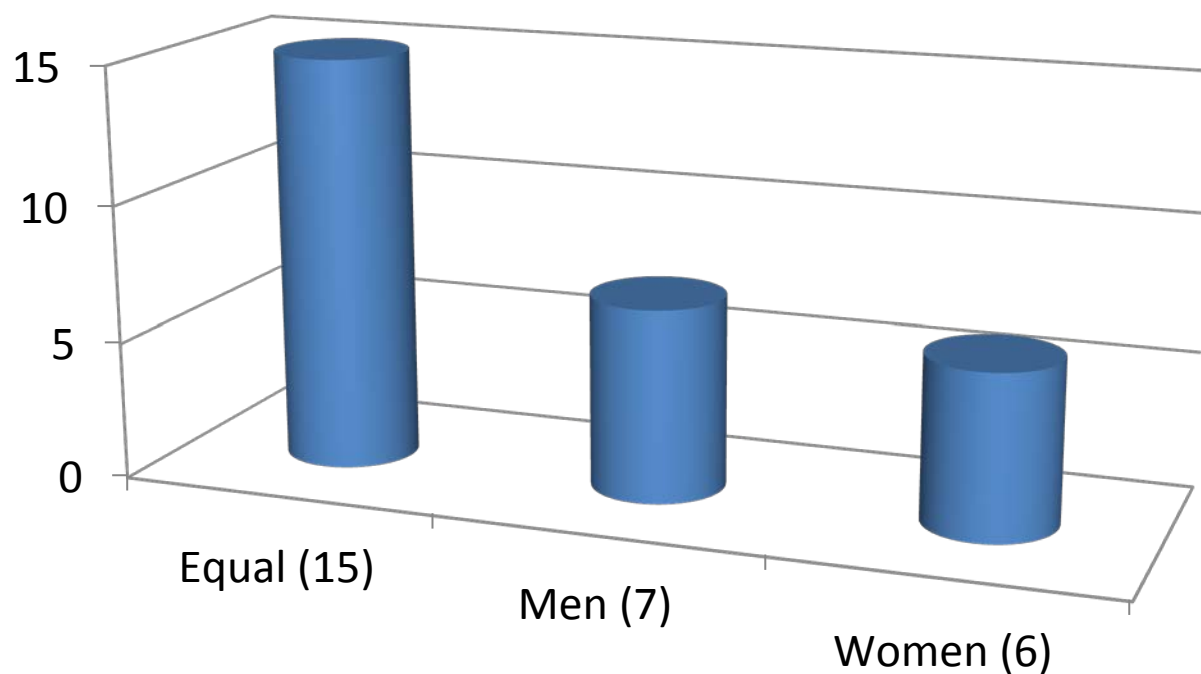

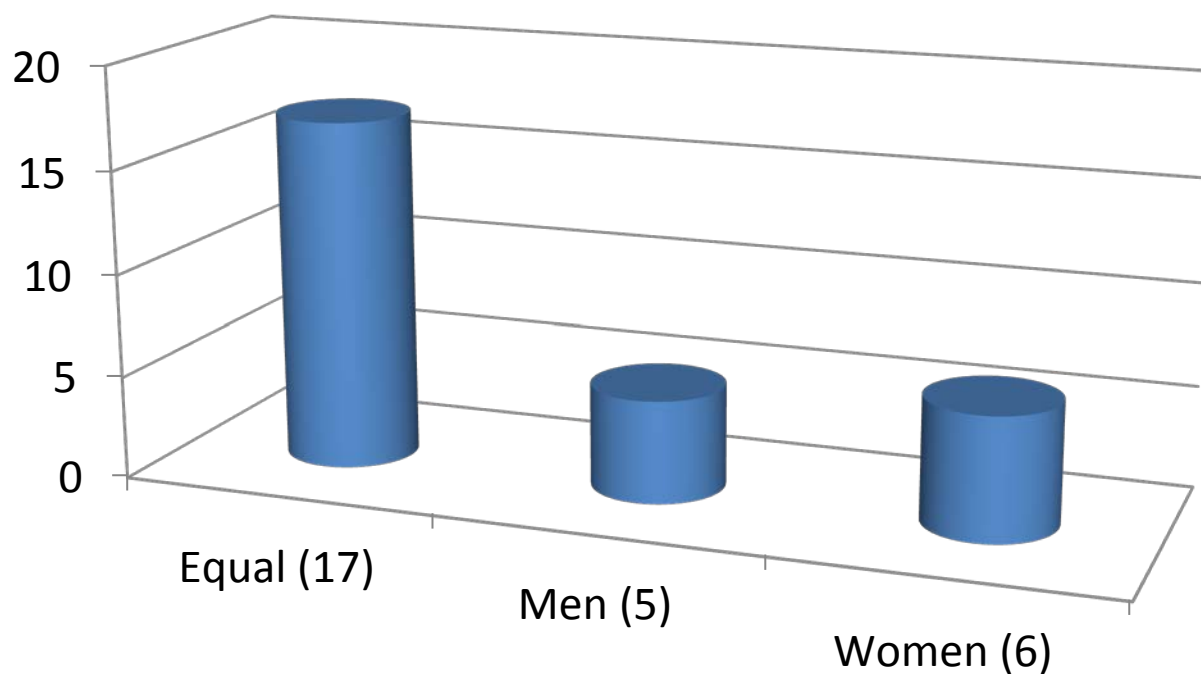
## Who can have better management skills?



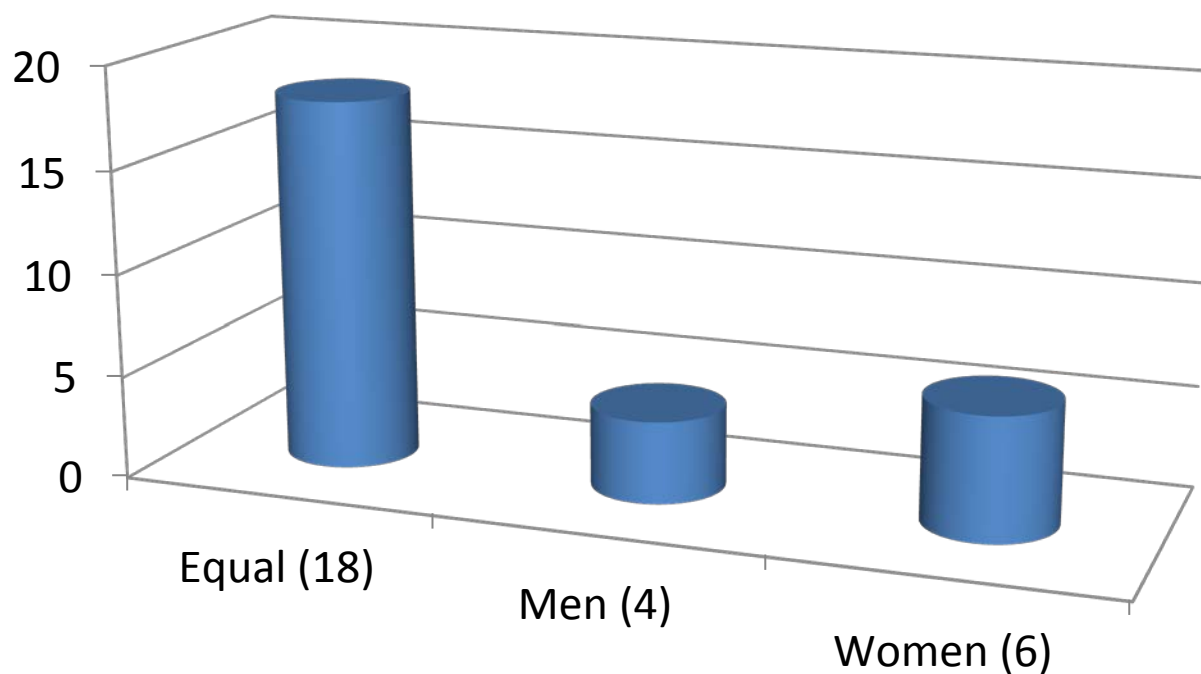
# Whom is it easier to persuade that your legal position is right?



## Who can more effectively work with huge amount of information?

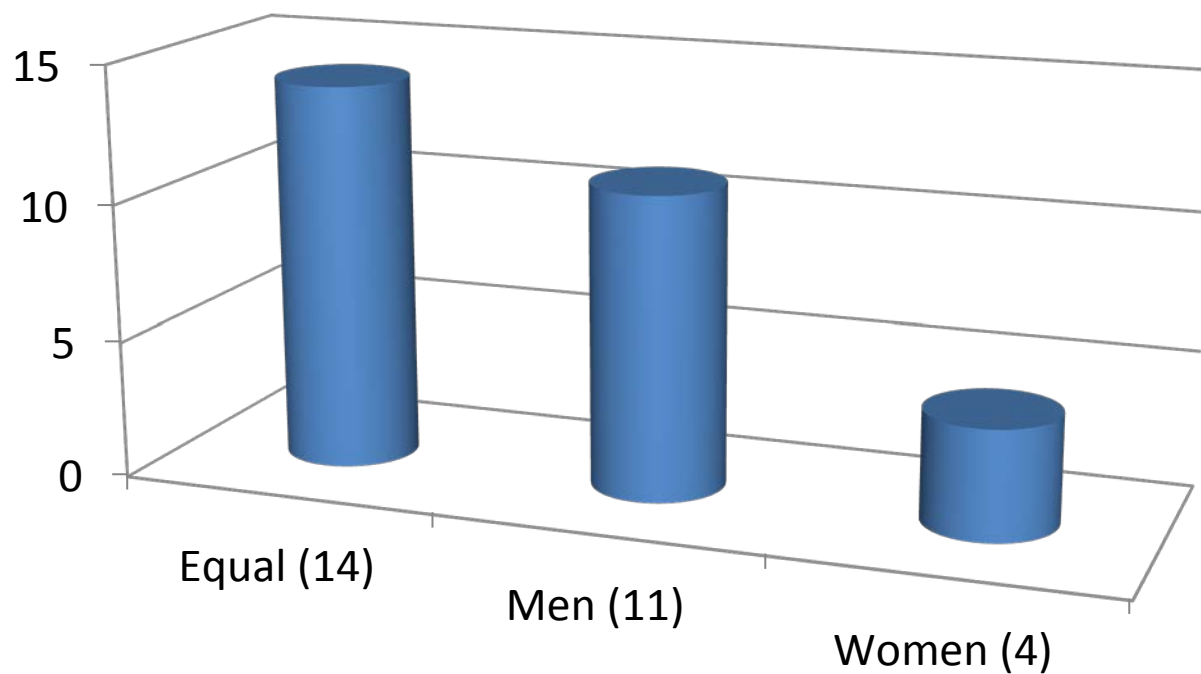


## Who can have more time for thorough trying of the case?

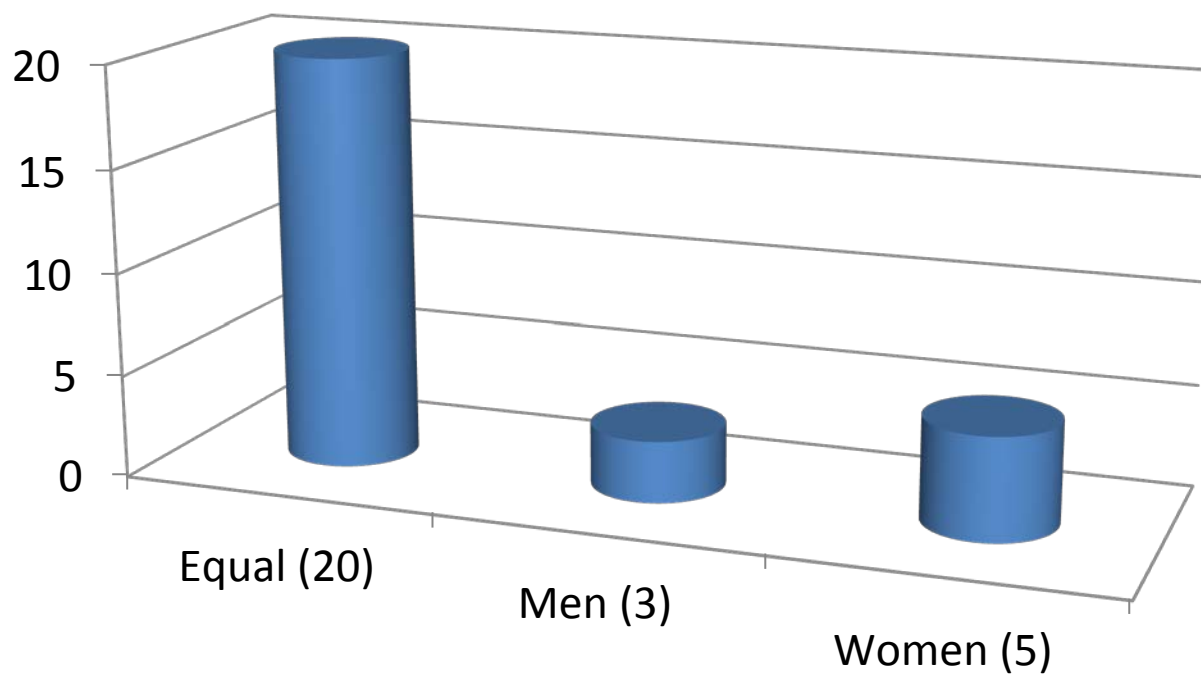




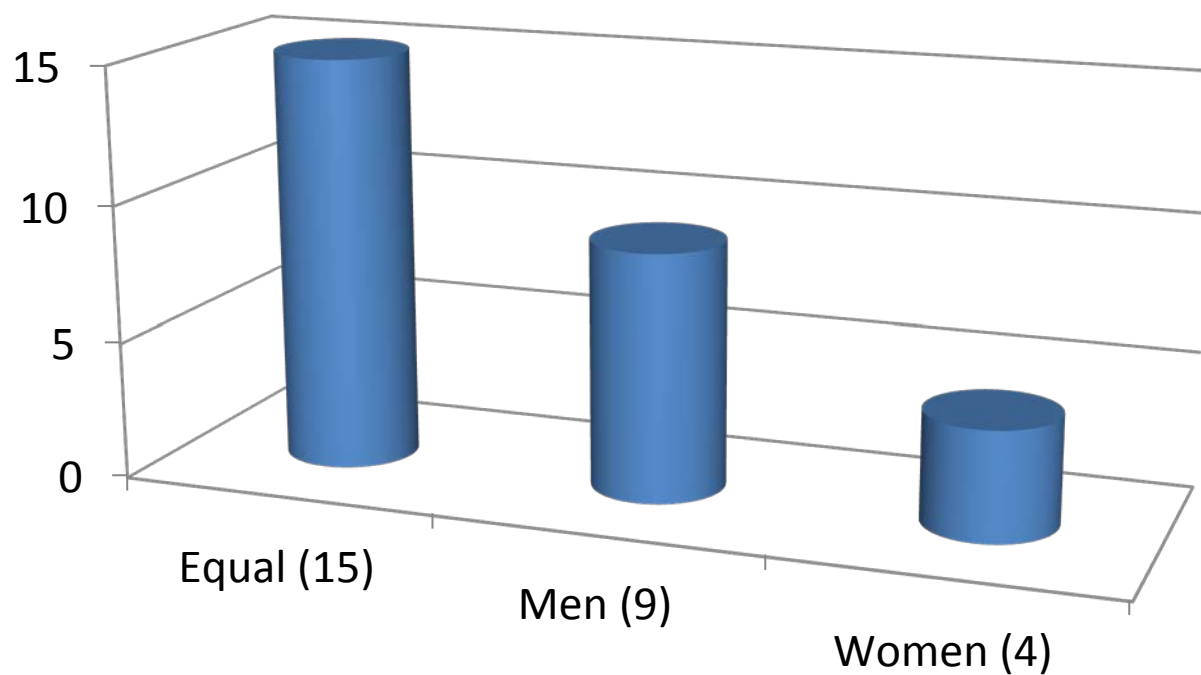
## Who is more predictable?



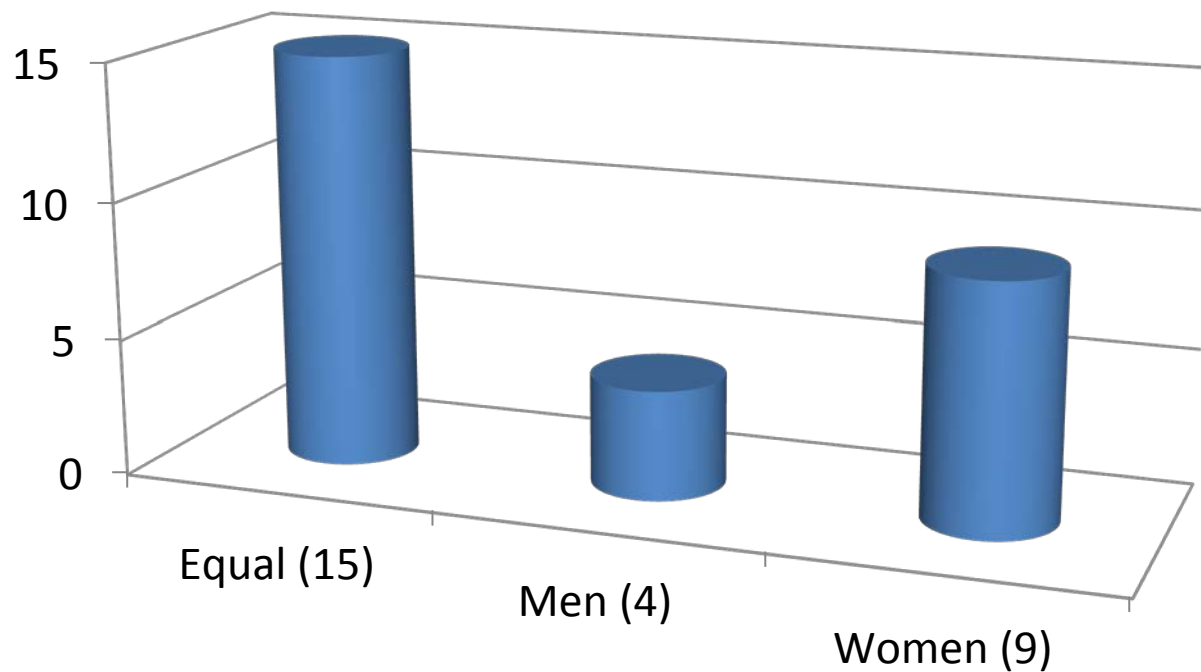
## Who as an arbitrator is more open-minded and fair?
